

# Wink APK MOD Video Editing Master Checklist

Streamline your editing for a flawless edits. Print & display!

## 1. Download & Install

- **Wink apk mod download** from safe site
- For latest features you must have **wink mod apk v2.6.0**
- On android go to settings and allows install from “Unknown Sources” in Settngs.

## 2. First Launch & Permissions

- Open your app & give access to storage, camera, and mic.
- Enable the “Premium Filers” and “Full Export Quality” on from settings.
- Turn on “Auto-Save Projects” so that your project always remains save.

## Pre-Edit Preparation.

Good quality work out saves your time. Practice the following steps befor starting your project.

-  **Folder Setup**
  - On your phone make folders (e.g Raw Footage, Images, Audio, Video)
  - Rename files with dates and descriptions (e.g,20250329 Kidsparty.mp4)
-  **Gather Assets**
  - Download your music and other sound effect in your audio folder.
  - Gather your logos, lower thirds, and other overlays in Graphics folder.
-  **Sketch an outline**
  - Clip (Which shot to be place where)
  - Action (What happens)
  - Notes (what text or effects to be used)
-  **Set Project Specification**

Open wink apk mod →New Project →Set resolution at (1080x1920 for vertical video) and 30 fps.

## Rough Cut Checklist. (H2)

Create the basic video structure first:

### 1. Import video clips

- Import those videos which you’ll use.
- Placed them onto the timeline you are using.

## 2. ✂ Trim Unnecessary clips

- Click on a clip, remove long pauses or mistakes

## 3. = Add Placeholders

- Insert your text layer where you can place additional footage later

## 4. 🔄 Audio Sync

- In case you had used an external mic, then sync its audio with camera audio.
- Then mute the camera track after syncing.

## 5. ▶ Play & Review.

Play your video at 0.75x speed to pinpoint awkward cuts or pacing issues.

This whole process will be a rough version that gives you story clearly.

## ✅ Fine-Tuning in Wink. (H2)

Polishing video's look and sound:

### 1. 🔄 Transition

- To make your cuts smooth add a 0.3 to 0.5 sec swipe or crossfade.
- Focus on one or two styles to make it consistent.

### 2. 🎨 Color & Filters

- For a simple look, use one-tape filter.
- For advance color control, Try Exposure, Contrast, and Saturation use 10% Exposure for brightness, 5% saturation for natural colors.

### 3. 🎧 Levels

- To place your volume even normalize your clips.
- In order to remove background noise use noise-reduction slider.

### 4. 📉 Music Ducking

- Set up automatically lower the music volume when the voice plays.
- Turn on "Auto-Duck"

### 5. 📈 Check Peaks

Maintain audio peak around 6dB in wink apk mod.

## ✅ Branding & Polish. (H2)

Make your videos stand out at a glance.

### 1. 🎬 Intro & Outro

- Add a 3-5 sec logo animation at the start of short.
- End up with with a CTA like "Subscribe for more"

### 2. 📝 Lower Thirds & Captions

- Apply clear, and bold text at the lower third area.

- The caption should be up to 5-7 words and for 2 sec on screen.

### 3. 🎉 **Stickers & Effects**

- Use only 2 animated stickers per scene.
- Your sticker should match to your brand's look.

### 4. 🗝️ **Watermark**

- Import your semi-transparent PNG log.
- Place it at the corner of your video with opacity of 20-30%.

## ✅ **Export Settings. (H2)**

In order to export the correct video you must go through the settings.

### 1. 📁 **Format & Codec**

- MP4 with H.264 is best format for all videos.
- 4 Mbps is best bitrate while exporting good quality video with low size.

### 2. 📺 **Resolution & Aspect Ratio**

- 1080x1920 or (9:16) is best for TikTok/Reels/Shorts.
- 1080x1080 or (1:1) is for Instagram feed.

### 3. 📄 **Filename & Versions**

- File name should be like this: Project Name\_Platform\_Date\_V1.mp4  
Example: Birthday\_Instagram\_20250426\_V1.mp4
- Use V1, V2, for edits.

### 4. 💾 **Backup**

Upload your final wink apk mod project to Google Drive or Dropbox.

### 5. ✅ **Final check**

- Check your exported file on your phone.
- Look for its audio glitches, pixel or cut-off text.
